


Whereas the former Commissioners of Property by one warrant bearing date the 10th of the 5th month 1689. Granted five hundred acres of land to be laid out to Tho. Fairman out of the overplus land of Mores land in right of his Purchase of eleven hundred acres of Tho. Hooder.

It appears that the said Thomas Fairman has sold & confirmed unto Richard Taylor three hundred acres of the same land (situate in the county of Philadelphia) ~~beginning~~ Beginning at an oak in the bounds of John Brooks land and running by the land of John Jones north west four hundred and eighty poles to a post. Thence south west by the said Fairman's land one hundred perches to a post. Thence south east by land late Rebecca More's deceased four hundred and eighty poles to a post. Thence north east by the said Brooks land one hundred perches to the place of ~~the~~ Beginning.
