



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May Anno 1706 for surveying unto Robert Ashton of Philad<sup>ia</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> five hundred acres of land in this Province. There was surveyd and laid out unto the said Robt Ashton a tract of land in the County of Philad containing five hundred and forty acres the said forty acres being added to make up a defect in another tract of ~~a~~ six hundred and forty acres which should have been above 680 acres (-o-b-l-i-t-e-r-a-t-e-d-) being bounded as is expressed in the Draught above.
