 These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee
 fourthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye said number
 of acres in manner aforesaid where not already taken up he seating
 and improveing the same within six months after ye date of survey
 and make returne hereof to ye Secretarys office dated at Philadel-
 phia ye 10th g^{mo} 1685.
