Know all Men, by these presents That we James Cornell John Cornell and Gilliam Cornell executors of the estate of Gilliam Cornell late of the Northampton township deceased by and with the consent of all the heirs of the said deceased) from motives of benevolence and humanity have manumitted and delivered by instrument and set free from slavery our negro man named Janet Beard aged about fifty years, and we do hereby give grants and release unto the said Janet Beard all our right title and claim, of, in and to his person labour and service and of in and to the estate and property which he may hereafter acquire or obtain In witness whereof We have hereunto set our hands and seals This twentieth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten
