



Surveyed the South and East side of the above described tract of land the 20<sup>th</sup>  
November 1846, and the North and West side thereof the 30<sup>th</sup> of January 1847,  
for which tract of land Thomas Wade has since procured a Warrant from the  
Com. of Penna bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1847. In Pursuance of which  
said Warrant I return the above Survey containing Two hundred and ninety  
six acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on the  
west side of Laurel hill in Fairfield Township and in the County of Westmore-  
land Penna (Given under my hand Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 1850)
