and above land Surveyed for Titus Matlack about eighteen Miles above Fort
Augusta in the County of Northumberland containing Two hundred and ninety eight
Acres & one hundred and eight perches besides the usual allowance of 6 $\frac{2}{3}$ per cent
for Roads etc. Surveyed the 8th day of June 1823 for Sam'l Shakespeare in pur-
suance of a Warrant dated the 16th day of Decemr 1822.
