



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres, dated the 2nd day of April 1794 granted to John Scott, was surveyed on the tenth day of February, 1831, the above described tract of Land, containing 416 acres and 134 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c.

Situate in Athens Township, Crawford county [it being the same tract which was surveyed on the 25th day of August 1799, for Joseph Beatty in pursuance of his actual settlement and improvement, bearing date the 24th day of May 1799]
