



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twentieth day of September 1734 Surveyed unto Gershom Benbow a tract of Land situated ^{in Rockhill Township} on a branch of Perkesonie, adjoining to William Allens land in the County of Bucks Beginning at a stone a corner of William Allens land thence by the same North East Two hundred and twelve perches to a white Oak thence by Vacant land North West one hundred and sixty perches to a post thence by Vacant land South West two hundred and twelve perches to a post in a line of the Mannor of Perkesonie thence by the same South East one hundred and sixty perches to the place of Beginning Containing Two Hundred Acres with the usual allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ cent
