



The above is a draft of a tract of Land situate on a small stream called Landing Creek or Little Towandy*, surrounding and adjoining on three sides of ^{a tract of land surveyed} Stephen Dural, on the west side and adjoining the Susquehanna River. Including in part the line between the Township of Wyalusing, and the Township of Towandy, in the County of Luzerne. Containing four hundred and five acres with the usual allowance of six per Centum for Roads. Surveyed for Samuel Baird, Agent for the Asylum Company in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Asa Osburn, dated the 13th day of August A.D. 1792. Resurvey the 16th day of December A.D. 1809.
