



By Virtue of a warrant dated 17th ~~September~~^{September} 1793. Surveyed 12th September 1793. to William Baird the above tract of land, situate on the branches of a small brook that empties on the East side of the North East branch of Susquehanna about half a mile below where it passes the State line between the fifty six and fifty seven mile stones in Luzerne County. Containing four hundred and six acres, and one hundred and twelve perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
