



The above is a draught of a survey made Decr. 9<sup>th</sup> 1784 in pursuance of a Warrent Granted to John Henderson dated Septt. 13<sup>th</sup> 1784 situated on the Owens Run, a branch of Wheeling Creek in Washington County Called the Falling Timber Containing four hundred acres with the allowance of six feet for Roads.
