

A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the waters of Loyalsock Creek adjoining land of William Grayberry & others in Loyalsock Township in the County of Northumberland Survey'd on the ninth day of November 1788 for Abraham Owen in pursuance of his warrant bearing date on the first day of July 1784. Containing four hundred & nine acres three quarter & the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.

This warrant was removed from the waters of Catawissa Creek the land being appropriated as appears by a certificate under the Hand of the Deputy Surveyor of that District &c.
