Surveyed on ye Twenty-fifth Day of November - John Sinnema Tract of Land
 Situate on a branch of Perkiomie Near Newciseayoyain in the County of
 Philadelphia Beginning a post at Corner of Hans Bowers land thence by land
 of Humphrey Hill North forty degrees East one hundred and Eighteen
 perches to a post at corner of the said Humphrey Hill land thence the
 same course by Vacant land forty one perches to a post thence by Vacant
 land North fifty Degrees West one hundred and sixty perches to a post thence by
 Vacant South forty Degrees West one hundred and fifty nine perches to a Hickory
 at Corner of s^d Hans Bowers land thence by the same South fifty Degrees
 West one hundred and sixty perches to the place of Beginning Containing one
 hundred and fifty acres with usual allowance.
