



By Virtue of a Warr^t from the Commission^o of Property bearing date the 10th day of the second month 1718. Surveyed and laid out unto William Smith a Tract of land in Wrightstown in Bucks County, Beginning at a post in the line of the Town Square being a corner of the s^t Smith's other Land, from thence extending by the s^t Land South 20 degrees East 290 perches to a post by a small black oak, Then by overplus Land West 6 degrees South 90 perches to a small white oak, Then by John Penquites Land North 6 degrees West 266 perches to a heap of stones in the afores^t line of the Town Square Then by the same North East 26 perches to the place of beginning. Containing 96 Acres. Certified under my Hand this 25th day of the 12th month 1718.
