



Surveyed on 061 day of July 1734 to Hans Yoder a Certain Tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Philad. Beginning at a Hickory being a Corner of his other land, thence by the same South East one hundred & Seven perches to a post, thence by land of Gabriel Boier South West Sixty Six perches to a post thence by land of David Coffman North West one hundred & Seven perches to a post, thence by land of Anthony Lee North East Sixty six perches to the Place of Beginning containing forty one Acres with usual allowance.

By Warrant from the Proprietaries dated 4<sup>th</sup> 24 day of January Anno 061 1733 Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> of the same Month 061 turned into the Secretaries office the 24<sup>th</sup> 061 L<sup>o</sup> H. D. 1734 P. B. C. J. G.
