



The dotted lines in the above diagram represent the Survey of John Crawford Senr made at the time and by the authority therein stated. The plain lines represent the Survey of John Kelly made the 26th of March 1788 by war^t of the 28 February 1775. That part of the diagram within the dotted lines including the letters A. B. C. shows the interference of John Kelly with John Crawford Senr. John Logan occupies and claims one hundred acres under the title to Kelly. Crawford's tract is patented. the residue of John Kelly's Survey is occupied and owned by the heirs of Frederick Pershon Dec^d Situate in Wheatfield Township Indiana County. Examined and ascertained the said interference on the 22^d Oct^r 1827 In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal & interest due the Commonwealth &c. and by the authority of the Board of Property
