



Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Southampton Township Franklin County Containing 72 Acres 45 perches & Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c Surveyed 8th November 1768 on an Order of Survey to Michael Kerr dated 30th August 1768 for 5153 & returned as per List of Unpatented Lands. Report of the above Tracts interferes with the following Surveys to wit: The part marked A containing 26 Acres 80 perches interferes with a Survey of 200 Acres made 21 May 1787 on Warrant to Conrad Coimer dated 8 May 1787. Owned & occupied by Michael Kerr under said title. The part marked B containing 45 Acres 134 perches interferes with a Survey alleged to be made on a Warrant to Michael Kerr dated 1st January 1775 owned & occupied by John Brakenridge.

Note: The whole of the Land held on the Warrant to Michael Kerr as well as that held on the Warrant to Conrad Coimer appears to have been held or recognised as the Land of William Kerr or Carr as early as the year 1751,
