



Situate between the Little Crossing and North Fork of Turkeyfoot in Turkeyfoot Township (formerly Bedford) now Somerset County and Surveyed the 24th day of June 1796 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted unto the said John Nichola for 150 acres dated 5th March 1796. But Certified by the Secretary of the Land Office to have entered for 250. Then is Lake and cause whereof is Certified by David Kennedy Esquire the 16th day of June 1796. Also certified by the Surveyor General on the 17th day of the same month and permission by him given to Alexander McClean Esq; then U.S. to fill the warrant agreeable to the description hereof &c —
