



Situate Between the Little Crossings & North Fork of Turkeyfoot,  
in Turkeyfoot Township, Somerset (formerly Bedford County) &  
Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1796 by Alex T. McLean Esq.  
D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 150 Acres dated the 5<sup>th</sup> Ma-  
rch 1796. But Certified by the Secretary of the Land Office to  
have been entered for 250 Acres. The Mistake, & Cause whereof  
is Certified by David Kennedy Esq. the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1796.  
Also Certified by the Surveyor Genl on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of the same  
month, & permission by him given to fill the same agreeably  
to the description dec'd as appears by the Official Drawing  
& endorsement on the Warrant. Certified & Returned the 9<sup>th</sup> day  
of March 1830.
