

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands herein mentioned, and by virtue of a commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Gulkens Esq; Surveyor General for the ob. of Pennsylvania - same directed bearing date at Philada. the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing Three hundred and thirty one Acres and Eighty Nine Perches and allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c. was surveyed on the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1785 by —
