 Dated the first day of March 1733 Surveyed to Joseph Town-  
 send a tract of Land Situate on a branch of Tokikon called  
 the Deep run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Corner post  
 of John Kennards land thence by the same North East one hun-  
 dred and forty one perches to a post another Corner of ye sa  
 John Kennards land thence by Vacant Land South East one hun-  
 dred and Eighty perches to a Black Oak thence by Vac. Land  
 South West one hundred and forty one perches to a post in the line of  
 Wm. Allens land thence by ye same North West one hundred and eighty  
 perches to the place of beginning Containing one hundred and  
 fifty acres with usual allowance of Ten p Cent.
