


Broad Way

In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Prop-
erty dated the 16th of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d
day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town
of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, Being number-
ed in the general Plan of said Town Sixty Four, and granted
to James Tilghman Esqr. containing in Breadth North and
South fifty seven feet Six inches and in Length East and West
Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Eastward by River Alley
Northward by Lot number Sixty Three Westward by Broad Way
and Southward by Shamokin Street as by the general Plan of said
Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
