made the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>d</sup> mo. 1747. for John McCleary  
in Pursuance of a Warrant Bearing Date the \*<sup>14<sup>th</sup> Day  
of November 1746, Survey'd by John Churchman, & Sit-  
uate on the Branches of Elk River in Oxford (form-  
erly London-Derry) Township, Beginning at a Span-  
ish Oak, a Corner of the Lands of John McCurdy &  
James White, & running thence South 47° East 59 perch-  
es yds as of the Draught, laid down on a scale of 80 yds to  
an inch; The Tract is lately Purchased by William Lig-  
gett</sup>
