



A Draft of one hundred and eighteen acres and ninety six perches of land with six per Cent for Roads situate in Wayne Township in Allegheny, late Cumberland, county surveyed 29<sup>th</sup> April 1796 in pursuance of a warrant to William Bratton dated 26<sup>th</sup> October 1785 (for one hundred acres) said to contain 110<sup>a</sup> 5 pers Resurveyed 29<sup>th</sup> January 1818 for Philip Powell. Note about a fourth of the above land is in cultivation
