By a Rule of Court, referees were appointed to settle the dispute between Henry Brown & William Davis, - on the 21st of Nov^r 1805, they awarded that a line be run parallel with the line S 47 1/2° East 152.10s to Abraham Reidys Corner, so as to strike off 25. acres and no more, from the land claimed by the Defendant Henry Brown, and that the same be given to the Plaintiff Wm Davis
