



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Maccony Township in the County of Northampton [formerly Bucks], in the State of Pennsylvania, containing Fifty Acres of Land, with the usual allowance for Roads, which formerly was surveyed by Edward Scull for Christian Gorr, by Virtue of a Warrant, dated on the 17th June Anno 1745. — This same was afterwards resurveyed for him and divided. The greatest Part thereof is now belonging to his Grand Son George Gorr Junior — and the Remainder to Geo Kellier. Drawn again on the 25th October Anno 1783.
