Land of William Paxton and others on the waters of Waterbury or Royalsock creek in the County of ~~Franklin~~ Luzerne containing four hundred and sixteen acres & eighteen and eight tenths perches allowance &c, Surveyed for Robert Campbell the tenth day of April AD. seventeen hundred and nine by three by William Montgomery Q.S. my predecessor, by virtue of a warrant dated the twenty sixth day of February 1793, as appears by the original draught in my office, which survey I have examined & corrected.
