



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Blooming Garden situate in the Long Limestone Valley on the path leading from the Bald Eagle's Rest towards Franklin's Town about seven Miles from said Rest, on both sides of trout Run and including the head of a large Spring; adjoining and to the Southward of land surveyed for George Gabriel and Northward of Michael Shank's Land in Cumberland County containing three hundred and two acres, and the usual allowance of six per cent for road etc Surveyed the 25th Day of October 1770
for John Shank in pursuance of an Order No: 186 Dated the 3^d Day of April 1769.
