



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the encamping Place situated on Wills Creek about a Quarter of a Mile below the Beaver Dam adjoining & below John Shaw & adjoining and above William Robinson in Cumberland Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred & twenty three Acre and the usual Allowance of six & cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 12th & 14th Days of November 1774 for James Barclay in assurance of a Warrant Dated the 10th Day of Sept: 1762 by

To B. That part of the above Draught within the pricked Lines is returned for Thomas McCroskey; but it does not appear that any of the pricked Lines except that between the large rock of McCroskey's Nor Corner were ever run or marked; the lower end of McCroskey's Draught is said to join a Survey of Samuel Wallis; but no line to be found - see McCroskey's Return.
