


Take This tract to the above 30 miles from Philadelphia

Pursuant to an Order Dated the 13th of August Anno Dom 1748 The above Described Piece of Land was Surveyed for the Use of the Proprietaries in the Township of Joshua Chester Co. Beginning at a Post at a Corner of the Land of David Davis. Thence by the same W.S.W. 72 pches to a W. Oak and N. 20° West 6 1/2 pc chl. To a Maple and W.S.W. 50 pces to a Spann. Oak Thence N. 25. W. by Vac^t C. 30 pces to a Chestnut Thence by the Settlement of Sectt. Oaks N. 65° E. 58 P. To a Spann. O. & N. 3d W. 17 pches to a Spann. O. & N. 65° E 80 P. To a Post Thence S. 3d E by the line of John Heal 62 P to the place of Beg^r Contg^a 35 1/2 acs & all^e
