



Detailed in Manazin Township York County and Surveyed the 21st day of December 1787 in pursuance of an Order of Survey for 200s. No. 5358, Dated the 1st Day of March 1769

N.B. The Application or order of Survey as above mentions the Land to be in Cumberland Township which has been an error in entering as William Cheesey and Patrick Dick - 1782 - "t2 - Run upwards of three miles as under and the Survey between their Lands, the Mountain being mostly vacant at the time of the location. On Resurveying the County line the last Summer I find a part of this Survey is in Franklin, part in York and part in Cumberland Counties, altho no marks of the line which had been run 10 years ago could be found within some miles of Mountain Creek. I made a return of the above Survey into the Surveyor General's Office in the Spring of 1788, but am now informed that it is not to be found.
