



A Draft of forty one acres and one hundred and forty two perches of Land with six per Cent for Roads. Situate in Wayne Township in Mifflin County, Surveyed 12th January 1815 in pursuance of a warrant to James Braxton dated March 22nd 1814. Note. Improvement at time of Survey w<sup>c</sup> Cabin with Richard Montgomery's family in it and at least two acres of land under good fence & in estate of Cultivation. James Braxton claims the above represented land for himself and the heirs of Samuel Braxton by his warrant dated 21st of March 1815.
