



A Draught of a Tract of Land Called Hickory Hill, (being part of a Tract called Spring Grove), Situate on the waters of Kechenypawings run about four miles North of that point of the Old Road leading from Bedford to Fort. Pitt where the same crosses the Beaver River, adjoining South of Land of John Robinson in Brothers Valley Township in the County of Bedford Containing two hundred and eighty two acres and the usual Accouance of Six yds. Cost for Roads &c Surveyed the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of Septr. 1770, for George Campbell in pursuance of an order No. 2904. Dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 1769 by Thomas Smith D.S.
