



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Decr. 5<sup>th</sup> 1784 In Pursuance of a Warrant. Granted to Joseph Rigby dated the 21<sup>st</sup> <sup>day of</sup> October 1784. Situate on the waters of Bark Camp Run. Adjoining John Brown, in Washington County. Called Seven Bush. Containing four hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six Cent for Roads.
