



Situate in Cummings Township Lycoming County on the North East bank of Pine Creek opposite to Englishes and Sugar Islands and bounded as above described, Resurveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1840 by virtue of an order of Resurvey granted by the Board of Property on Petition of Hezekiah Stowel, Peter Dickinson D. B. R. Dickinson, Anson G. Phelps, W<sup>m</sup> E. Dodge, Daniel James & Samuel Dickinson bearing date 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1840 and a warrant granted to Michael Miller & William English bearing date the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1830 - Containing fifty eight acres with allowance of six per cent for Roads &c
