



Situate on Whippoor-will Run a Branch of Redstone Creek in Menallen Township Fayette County and Surveyed the 29th day of April 1835 in pursuance of a Warrant for 165 acres of Land, in the names of Isaac Meason & Daniel Rogers in trust & dated the 13th of April 1835. There has been 8 or 10 acres cleared, a part of which is now inclosed & cultivated, a small stone house in which a family is residing, and the remains of an old Chabin which was built some 30 years ago. This survey incloses a little too much land, ~~does not exceed ten per cent~~ but, as it just takes in the whole vacancy, and the land being very poor and hilly would probably be lost to the State if thrown out. I have ventured to return the whole, and hope this small excess will not prevent acceptance as the surplus will be paid for.
