Bimonte in Tyrone Township Fayette County to be understood as follows, the dotted lines, 107 $\frac{3}{4}$ ac was surveyed 17 Dec't 1785 to James Blackstone in Right of Valentine Crawford go^t. Order No. 520 of 3^d April 1769, the whole survey, black lines, of 318 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres surveyed ^{including the above} same day to James Blackstone in Right of John Minter go^t in Right of 9th Feby 1780. This land is owned by James Hurst or Husw on the premises, said to have been patented to James Blackstone, dec'd. Now returned on Crawfords location by virtue of contract with the Board of Property.
