



These may Certifie the Surveyor General's office that pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of Edward Shipp sent Griffith Owen Thomas Story And James Logan the Prop^{er} And Governor's Commis^s of Property and seal of y^e Province bearing date the 1st of y^e 10th Mo 1701 I Surveyed to George lead two hundred acres of Land in y^e manor of Rock Lands & in the County of Chester beginning at a Chestnut in Concord line being also a Corner of Nathan Newlin's Land thence south 24 deg. East in y^e S line seventy five perches and a half to a White Oak thence West South West 3 7/8 perches to a Black Oak in the division line of y^e County thence in y^e S line North 80 deg. West 86 perches to a post thence North North East 39 perches to a post thence East N.W. East 1425 perches to the first mentioned Chestnut. Survey'd Measured and layd out the 23^d of y^e 10th Mo 1701
