



The Drafts of two Tracts of Land situate in Newton Township in the County of Cambria, No. 1, containing one hundred and fourteen Acres and an allowance of six and one-half acres for Roads &c Survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant granted to David McCurdy bearing Date the 12th Day of June 1762. & No. 2 containing one hundred and sixtyone Acres & thirty two Perches and the Allowance aforesaid. Survey'd in pursuance of another Warrant granted to David McCurdy bearing Date the 5th Day of July 1785 in being the land remaining to David McCurdy agreeable to the Judgment of the Men appointed by an Order of the Honorable the Board of Property of the 6th of June 1785, to alter and regulate the Surveys &c in the case between S. McCurdy and Sarah Davis then on Vacant
