

Biddle Esq: James Starr and Benjamin Lightfoot and to the Northward of the Provincial Road leading from Francis Garnell's to Fort Augusta Sunbury &c in the County of Northumberland containing one hundred and seventeen acres and one hundred and thirty six perches besides the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 4th Day of November 1823 for Michael Thompson in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 28th Day of September 1823 —
