Originally surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> of the 2<sup>nd</sup> mo 1794. by William Keersey late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 25<sup>a</sup> Granted to Abraham Hoosier bearing date the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of February 1794. Resurveyed by the old lines the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September Ad: 1808, at the Request of Andrew Bower the present owner who desired us to make Return of the Draught.
