



A draft of a tract of land situated in Warriors Mark Township, Huntingdon County, containing one hundred and fifty acres, 73 perches and allowance of six per cent, being a part of a larger tract of land said to contain five hundred and fifty-seven acres and allowance which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Baynton and Samuel Wharton (No. 12) dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1766.

This part resurveyed and divided from the residue of said tract, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1862, for George T. Bearhoof.
