



Situate on the main branch of Keuzna Creek joining the south end of Wm Bingham & Co in the last purchase District No. 4 surveyed the fourth day of July 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant No. 2469 to Willem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eghen Hendrik Vollenhoven and Reutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 ac containing Nine Hundred and Ninety ac the usual allow^e of dist^y etc.
