of February 1885 In Consequence of a Certificate issued by the Commissioners appointed by the State of Vir-  
ginia to settle the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia & Ohio  
Of which the following is a true Copy —

Be it known by these presents, that the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to un-  
patented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Pocahontas, and Ohio, do hereby Certify, that George Craft is intitled to  
four hundred acres of land in the County of Monongalia on the waters of Dunlaps creek, to include his Set-  
tlement, made, in the year of our lord One thousand seven hundred and Seventy two also One thousand  
Acres in right of Preemption adjoining thereto.
