Bearing Date 15<sup>th</sup> February 1799 which had been Surveyed to James Jones by David Peck on her Warrant Bearing Date 15<sup>th</sup> of April 1785 Called Grays Head Situate in Green Township on the Waters of Big Neshaminy Creek and Containing 397 Acres and 134 perches with allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
