



By Virtue of a Warrant to Alse Jordan (alias Coleman) and Patience Jordan for thirty Acres of Land dated September the first A.D. 1801 have surveyed the above described tract of land situate on the North side of Muddy Run in the Township of Lower Oxford in the County of Chester containing Seventeen Acres and sixty Six perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
