Containing as above set forth 10<sup>a</sup> & 13<sup>l</sup> Perches and the  
usual allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 53<sup>a</sup> and  
allowances &c. which was originally Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day  
of November 1787 by John Forsyth late U.S. Surveyor  
for Jonathan McCreary for Execution of a Warrant Issued  
to Jones Chamberlain bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of March A.D. 1749. Resurveyed and divided off from the  
said larger Tract by the said Forsyth on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of  
February 1797. And now at the request of the owner  
Peter Mathias the same has been calculated Exam-  
ined &c. and found Correct and his request return-  
ed for Confirmation the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1813.
