Gilley and Mr. John Moore, respectable Gentlemen chosen by Tras Wilson, Carr. Powell & Hugh W^m Cornfield Surveyors of their Land so as to make it most convenient for each of them singly of the above described Land for Tras Wilson containing Three Hundred & Thirty Acres & 134 perches with an addition or portion of six acres 236 Acres & 61 perches of the same described Land was on the 14th Dec^r 1785 for the Survey of Wattick Dated May 18th 1785.
