



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} propriet^{rs} bearing Date the twenty fifth Day of Sep^r 1735 I have Surveyed and laid out unto Wm Hartly Merc^{ht} in the Township of Hopewell in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna River with Allowance of Six p Cent Beginning at a Hickery by Coneehage Creek Thence South Thirty Degrees Easterly one hundred & eleven pches to a White Oak Thence Six Degrees Westerly one hundred and sixty pches to an Elm Thence North Thirty Degrees Westerly eighty pches to an ash by the said Creek Thence up the same Traversing the severall Courses thereof Near about one hundred and eighty pches to the place of Beginning
 Surveyed May 26th 1739 P. me Zach Butcher D.H.S.
