

Whereas Robert McCrea Deputy Surveyor did on the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1770 Survey to William Menoch in Pursuance of two Orders viz No 493 & No 2761 a certain Tract of Land containing 575 Acres Situate on Forbes's Road about eleven Miles from Pittsburg and it is said that Hugh Donaldson purchased the said Land from Wm Menoch and now at the request of Matthew Garrison Adm<sup>r</sup> of said Donaldson I have divided the same Land and the above described Tract is a part thereof Surveyd Oct<sup>r</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> 1795.
